Gentlemen:

The Joint Committee on Alternative Work Schedules (Joint Committee), appointed on May 15, 2000, and charged with the task of developing a menu of 10- and 12-hour work schedules along with a method of implementing such schedules, met again on April 26, 2001. Following this meeting the Joint Committee recommended pursuant to #7 of the enclosed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) dated October, 2000, that a modified four, 10-hour work schedule (which provides for weekday and weekend coverage) be added to the menu as Schedule 10, and that an Alternative Outage Work Schedule (which provides rolling holidays and a daybreak that begins at the start of the dayshift) be added to the menu as Schedule 11. The Joint Committee also recommended pursuant to #8 of the above-referenced MOU that for the menu's Alternative Work Schedule #5 the daybreak be changed to start at the beginning of the dayshift.

Also enclosed is a memorandum from Bobby Klein, Secretary/Treasurer of the Trades and Labor Council for Annual Employees of the Tennessee Valley Authority (Council) to Peyton T. Hairston, Jr., Senior Vice President, Labor Relations, Tennessee Valley Authority, dated May 25, 2001, which states that the Council has met and concurs with the three recommendations mentioned above. Mr. Klein's memorandum also requests that TVA generate a document for both parties to sign showing that both TVA and the Council are in agreement with the revisions and additions recommended by the Joint Committee.


